




Summary of Suicide Deaths Among Minority Race and Ethnicities (Excluding White-Non-Hispanic) in Nebraska DEPT. OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES



In 2020 and 2021, among minority race and ethnicities (excluding White, non-Hispanic), Hispanic males with a high school education and between the age of 20-29 years old most frequently died from suicide. American Indian/Alaska Native non-Hispanic males were disproportionately impacted by suicide in Nebraska.



Other Decedent Characteristics Statistics are based on 63 cases. of total suicide deaths took place in a 79.4% residence. of total suicide victims experienced 20.6% homelessness or housing instability. of total suicide victims had previous mental 46.0% health problems. of total suicide victims were diagnosed 31.7% with depression. of total suicide victims were diagnosed 11.1% with bipolar disorder or anxiety disorder. of total suicide victims had history of 25.4% mental health treatment. of total suicide victims had current mental 17.6% health treatment. of total suicide victims were perceived by 60.3% others to be depressed at the time of death. of total suicide victims had a history of 38.1% suicidal ideation. of total suicide victims had a history of 22.2% suicide attempt. of total suicide victims had recently 25.4% disclosed their suicidal intent of total suicide victims had disclosed their 12.7% suicidal intent to their intimate partner. 30.2% of total suicide victims left suicide notes of total suicide victims had a history of 28.6% alcohol abuse. of total suicide victims had a history of 31.7% substance abuse other than alcohol. of total suicide victims had a history of 15.9% physical health problems. of total suicide victims had criminal or legal 14.3% problems. of total suicide victims had intimate partner 30.2% problems. of total suicide victims had family or other 14.3% relationship problems. of total suicide victims had known recent 15.9% argument. of the suicide deaths were among never 65.1% married individuals. of the suicide deaths were among married 20.6% individuals.
