








	77.0%	of total suicide deaths took place in a residence.
	18.9%	of total suicide victims experienced homelessness or housing instability.
	37.8%	of total suicide victims had previous mental health problems.
	25.7%	of total suicide victims were diagnosed with depression.
	8.1%	of total suicide victims were diagnosed with anxiety disorder.
	18.9%	of total suicide victims had history of mental health treatment.
	13.5%	of total suicide victims had current mental health treatment.
	64.9%	of total suicide victims were perceived by others to be depressed at the time of death.
	20.3%	of total suicide victims had a history of suicidal ideation.
	20.3%	of total suicide victims had a history of suicide attempt.
	20.3%	of total suicide victims had recently disclosed their suicidal intent.
	8.1%	of total suicide victims had disclosed their suicidal intent to their family member.
	28.4%	of total suicide victims left suicide notes.
	27.0%	of total suicide victims had a history of alcohol abuse.
