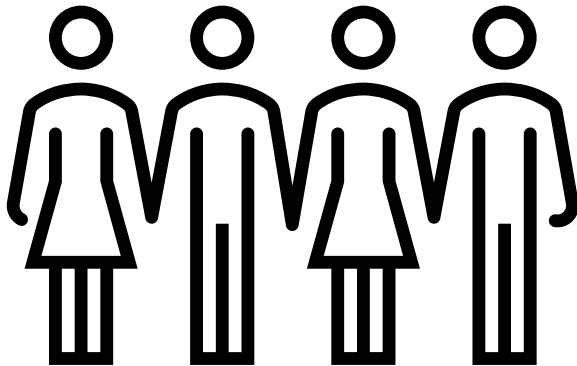
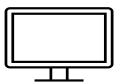


# Become a Certified Community Health Worker!
