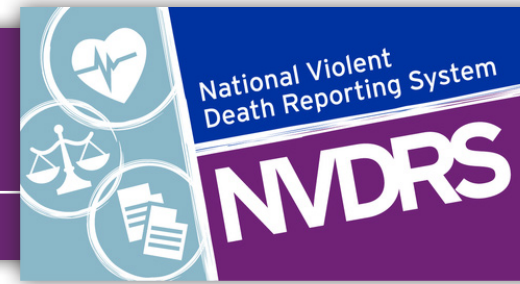
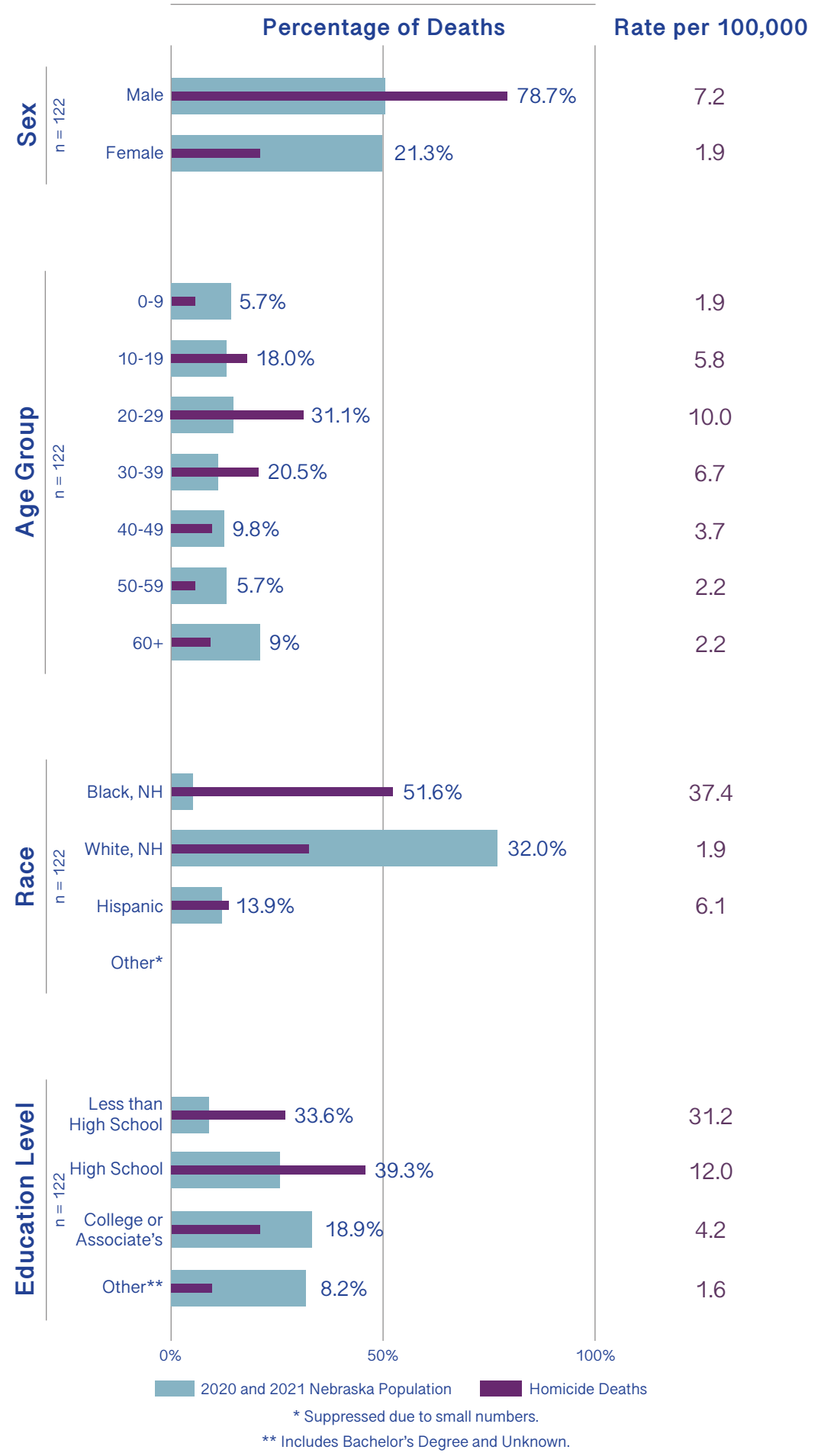


CDC NeVDRS - 2020 & 2021 Summary of Homicide Deaths in Nebraska Behavioral Health Region 5 & 6



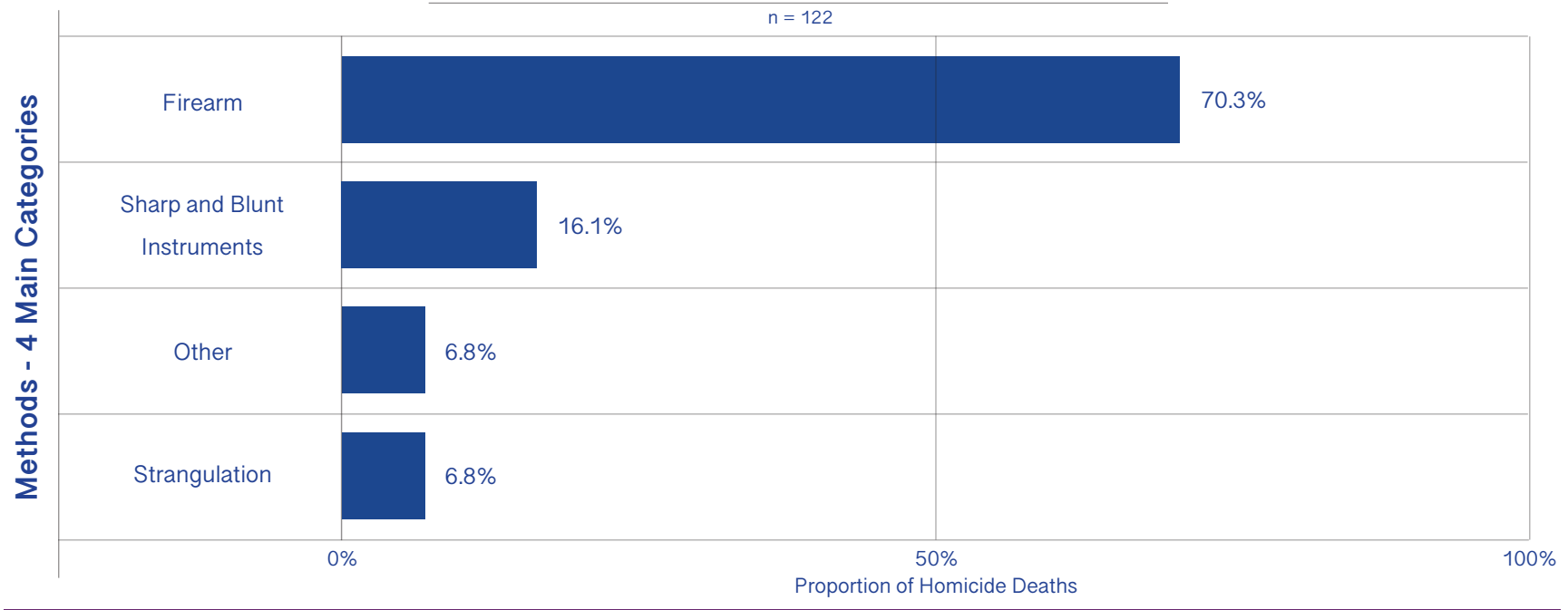
122 Total Deaths (4.6 per 100,000 Population)

Demographics

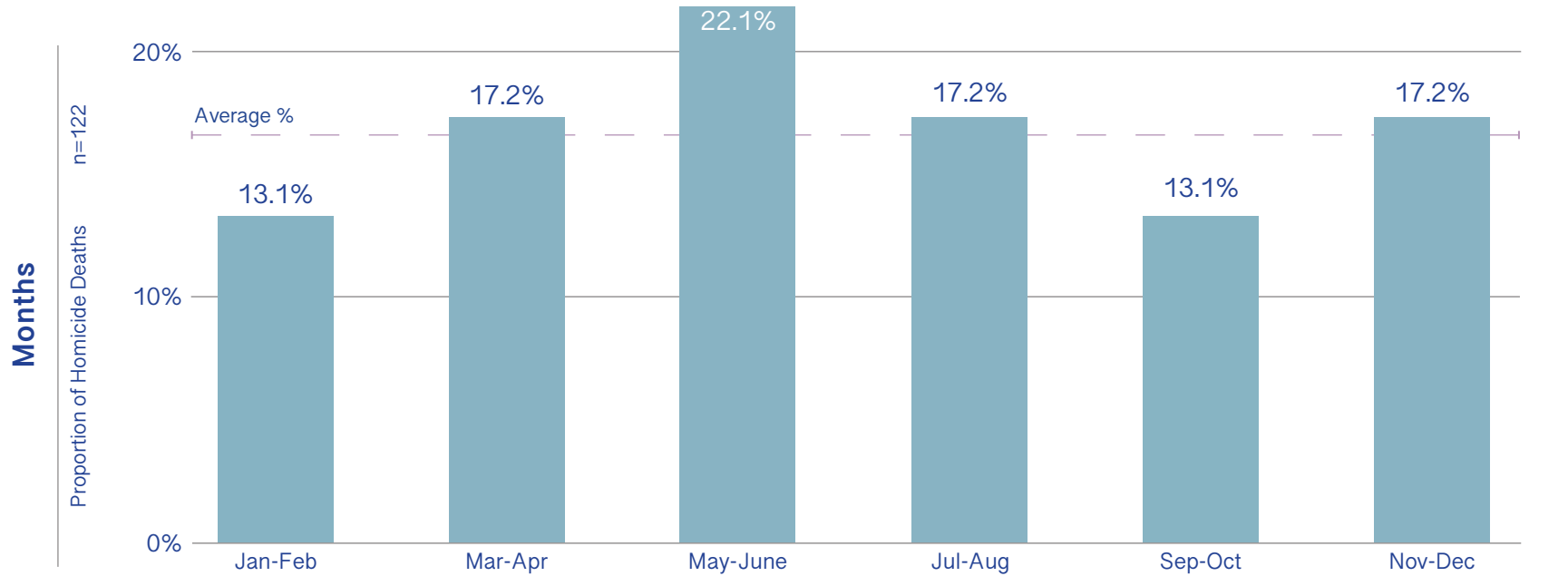


Demographics in Nebraska homicide deaths in 2020 and 2021 were not reflective of the population demographics. Black and Hispanic people died by homicide at higher rates than White people given their population size in Nebraska. Other risk factors that surpassed the Nebraskan population demographics were being male, between the ages of 20-29, and having a high school degree level of education or lower.

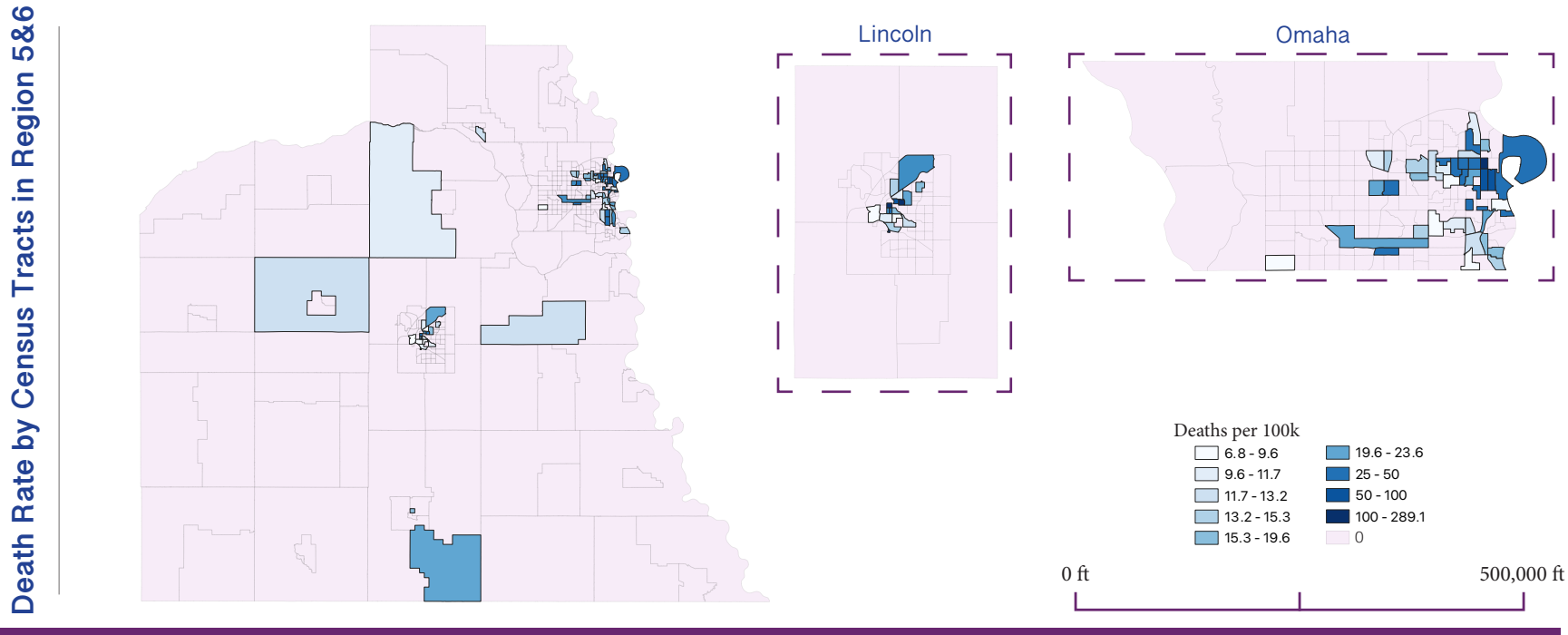
What methods were used?



In 2020 and 2021, individuals were most likely to be killed through use of a firearm.



The highest percentage of homicide deaths in regions 5 and 6 occurred in May to June in 2020 and 2021.



The darker blue areas on this map represent the highest rate of homicide deaths in Region 5 and 6 in 2020 and 2021.



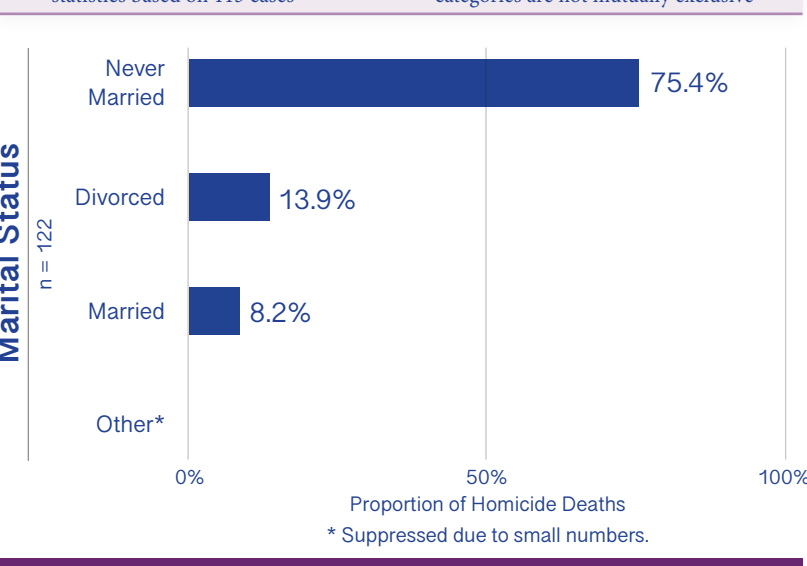
89.4% of total victims had emergency medical services present at the scene.

42.5% of total homicide deaths took place in a residence.

27.4% of total victims had 60 mins or less survival time.

49.6% of total victims had an argument or conflict that led to the victim's death.

38.1% of total homicide deaths were related to conflict between intimate partners.



Never married individuals were at the highest risk.
