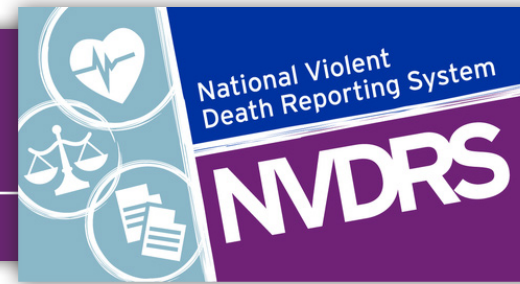


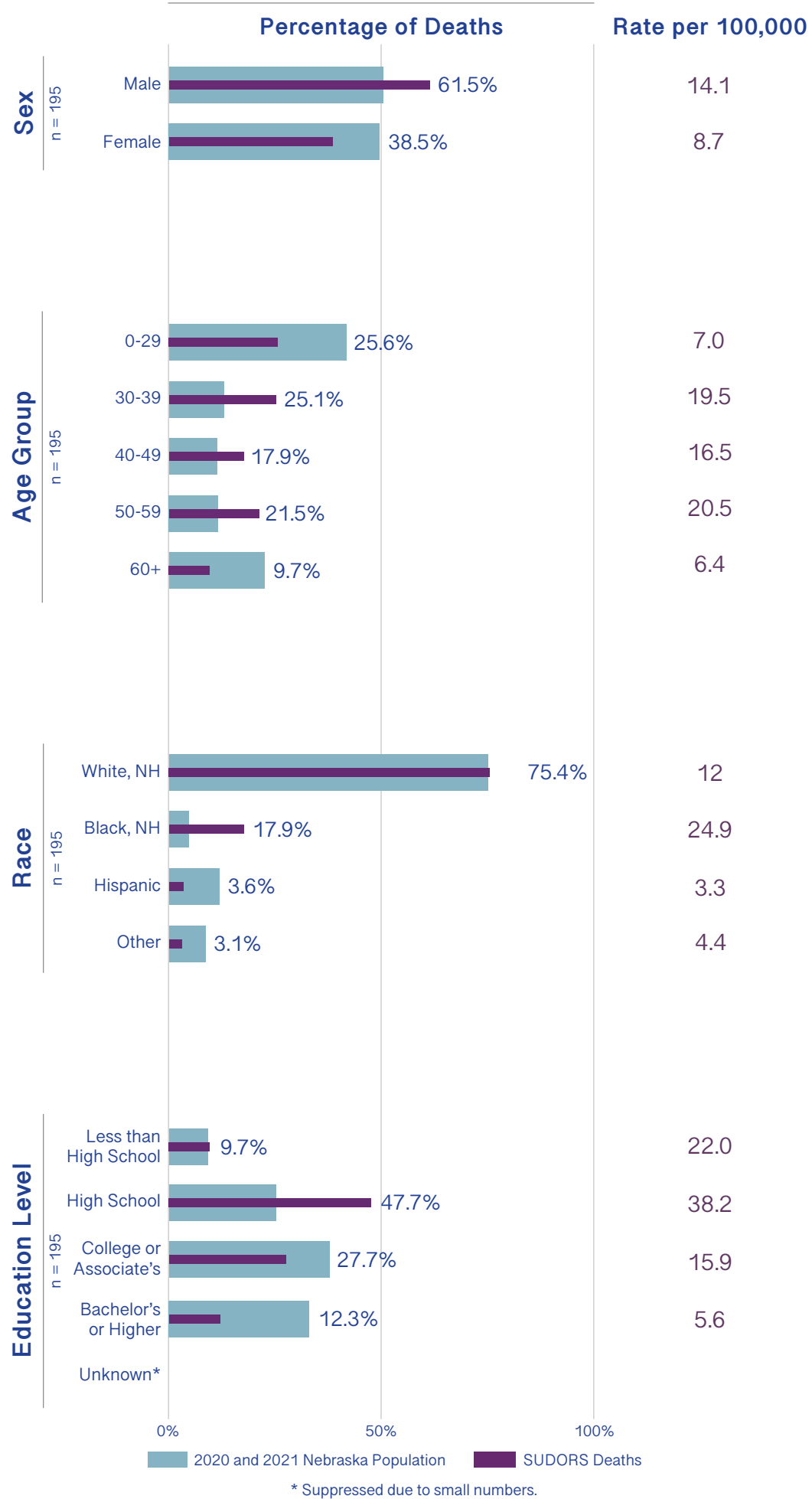

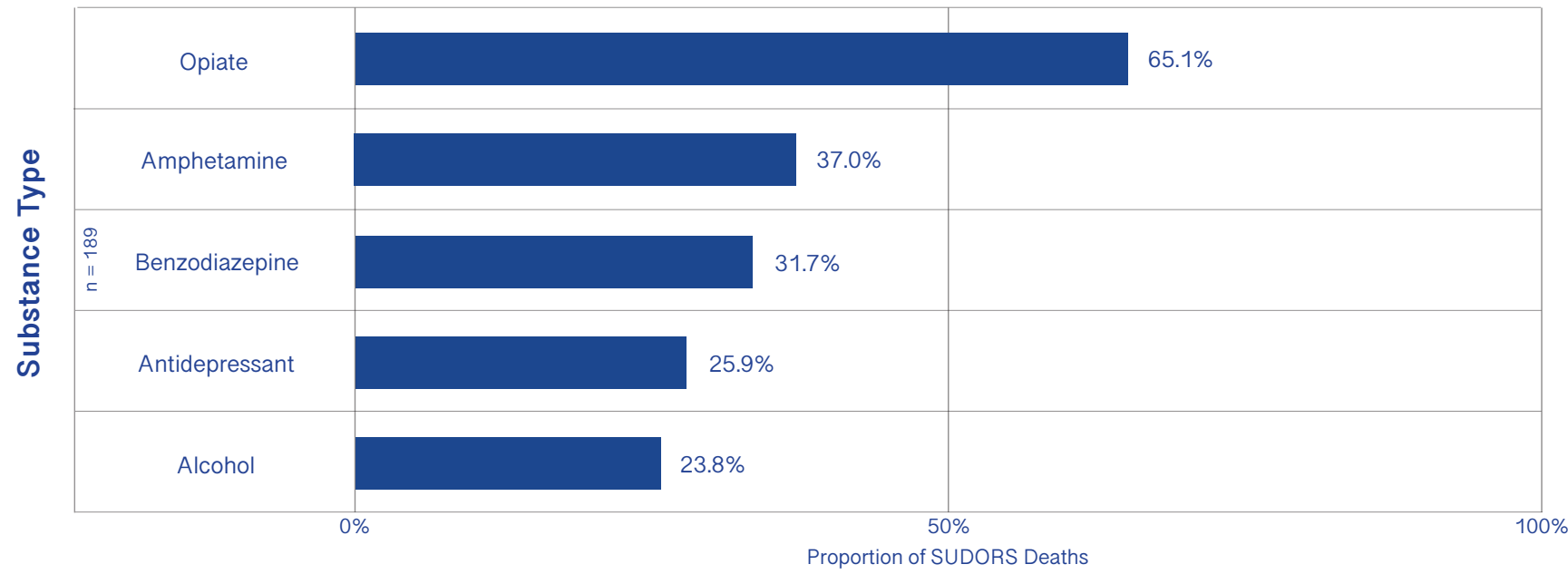

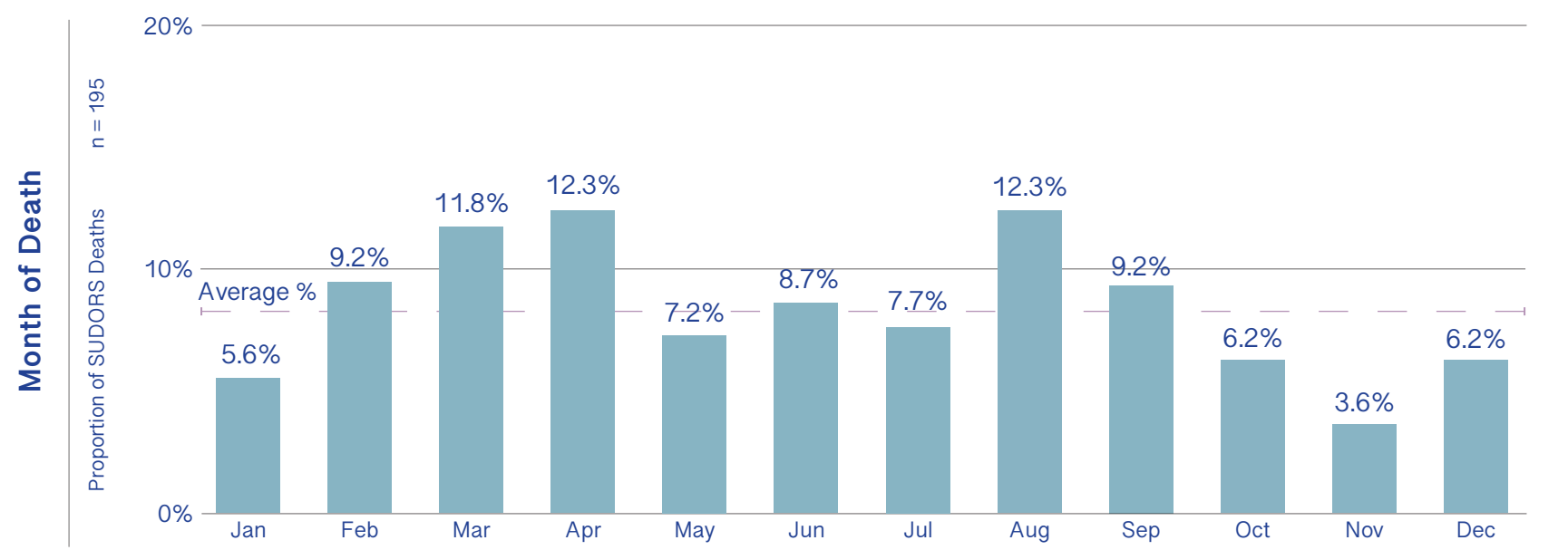


In 2020 and 2021, White males with a high school education between the ages 30-39 most frequently died from unintentional or undetermined drug overdose. Black people were disproportionately impacted by unintentional or undetermined drug overdose in region 6.

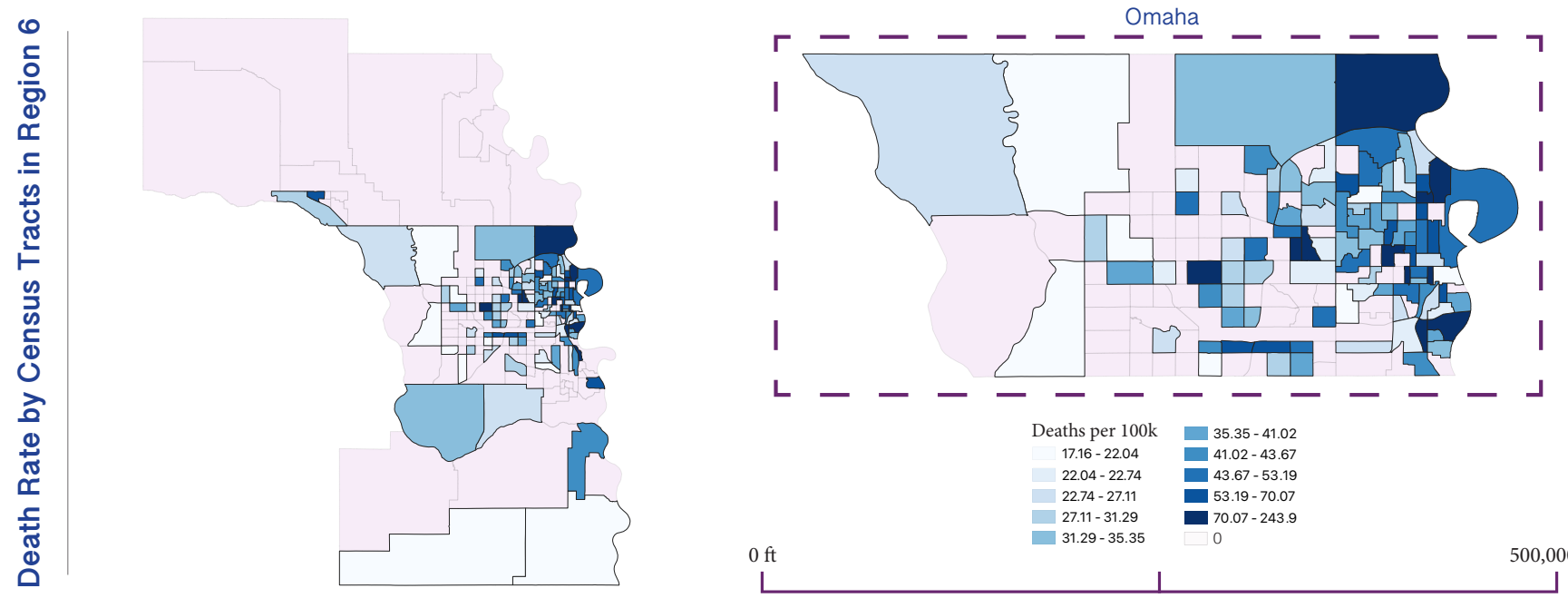
What drugs were involved in Region 6?



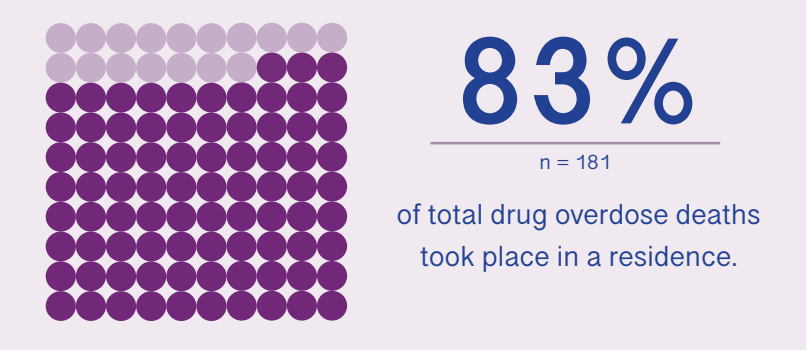
The top five drugs account for majority of all unintentional and undetermined intent drug overdose deaths in Region 6 in 2020 and 2021. Categories are not mutually exclusive.



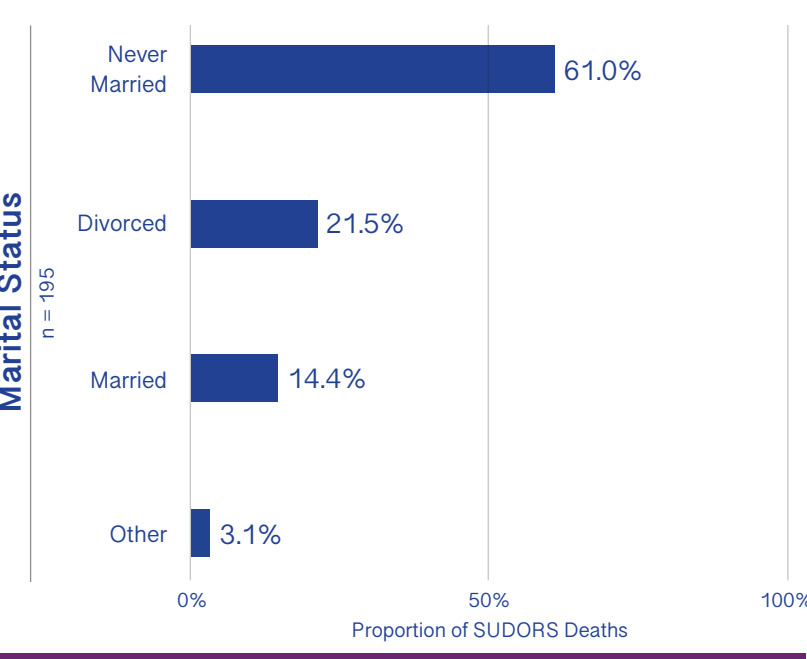
Unintentional and undetermined intent drug overdose deaths in Region 6 in 2020 and 2021 most commonly occurred in April and August.



The darker blue areas on this map represent the highest rate of unintentional and undetermined intent drug overdose deaths in Region 6 in 2020 and 2021.



- 26.0% of victims were perceived by others to be depressed at the time of death.
 - 28.7% of total drug overdose deaths had history of mental illness.
 - 15.5% of total drug overdose deaths had history of mental illness treatment.
 - 5.5% of total victims were disabled.
 - 11.6% of total victims were currently under pain treatment.
 - 8.8% of total victims have a record of previous overdose.
 - 23.2% of total victims have a history of alcohol abuse.
 - 18.2% of total victims had a bystander during the overdose death.
 - 5.5% of total victims have served in military.

Males who never married were at the highest risk.
