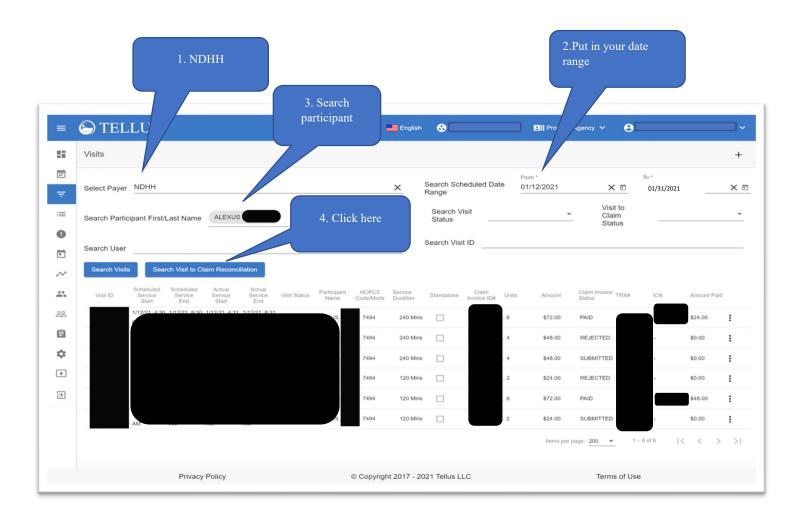

Scenario: Provider submitted claims for 1/29/2021 and he encounters REJECTED status within Tellus.

Some of his claims for 1/29/2021 have been paid, however, there are other visits which he has submitted were unable to be processed by DHHS.

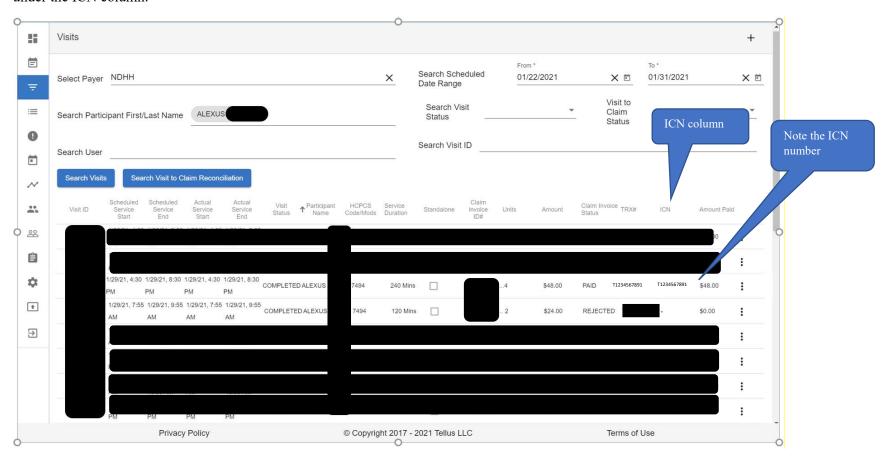

How to fix unprocessed claims in rejected status: Look for the Paid claim on the same day with the ICN number. Note the ICN number down. Best practice: Review your claims in the Visit tab by (1) put in the date range, (2) Select your payer, and (3) if you have more than one participant, enter a single participant in the field. Next, 'Search Visit to Claim Reconciliation'

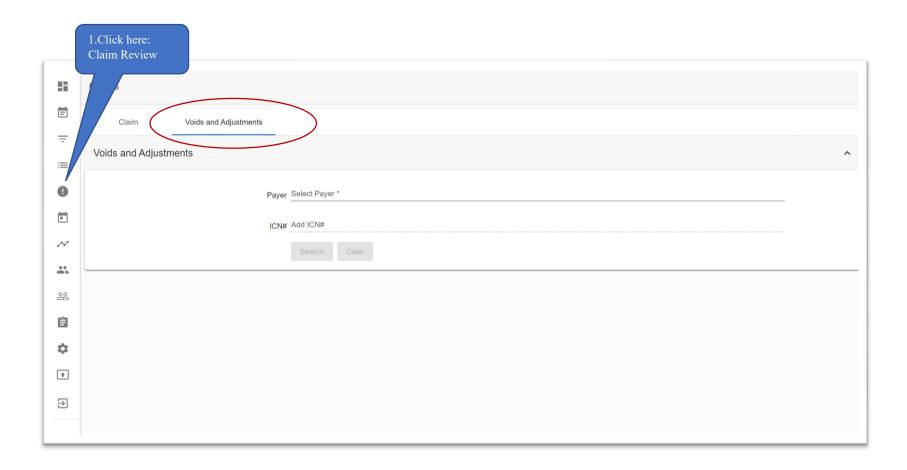


Make sure you review your visits. Do you have any Rejected statuses in your Visit to Claim Reconciliation list? In this example below, we are showing you a claim you submitted that has not been processed by DHHS, and is in a REJECTED status.

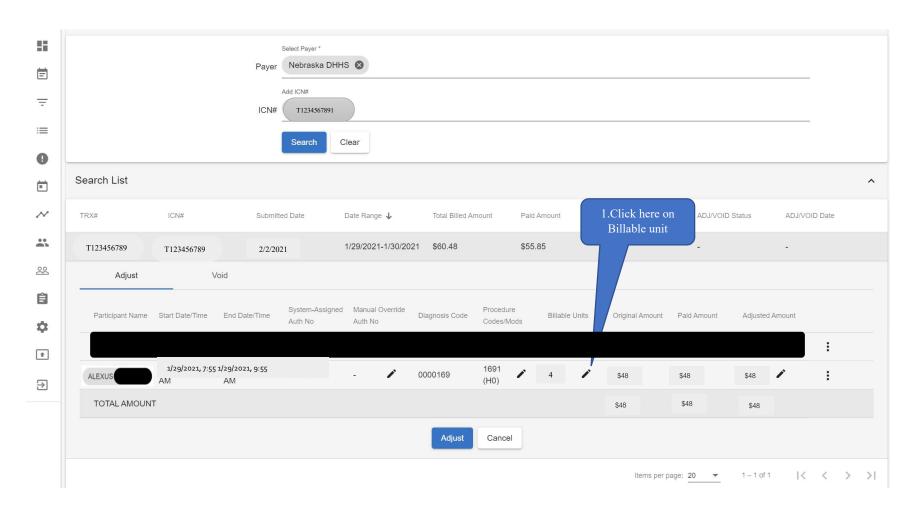
Review the date range from Service date: 1/29/2021 to 1/29/2021. Note that Service start time: **4:30 PM** to Service End time: **8:30 PM** is <u>PAID</u>. Now review your claim that is in a REJECTED status. Note that this claim on the same date but not the same time has been REJECTED. Make sure you have NO OTHER PAID CLAIM that is on 1/29/2021 with start time **7:55 AM** to End time **9:55 AM**. Now that you have validated that no claim has been paid for that specific time and date, review your 1/29/2021 paid claim. NOTE DOWN THE ICN NUMBER that starts with a Tunder the ICN column.

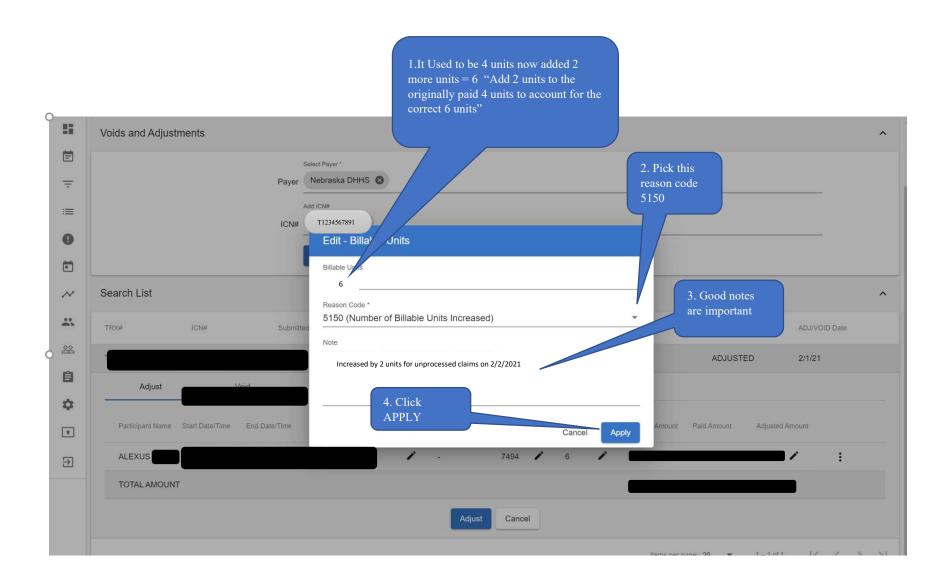


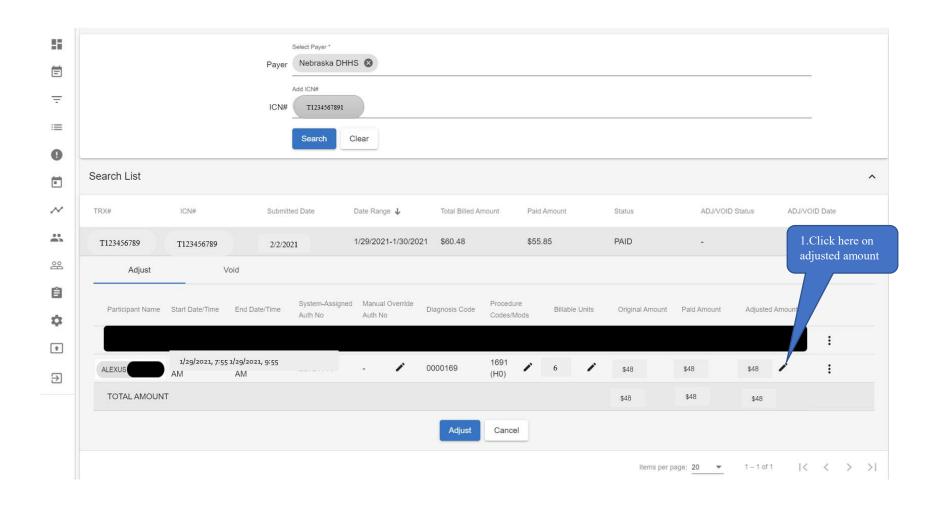
Now that you have noted the ICN number with the paid claim for the date of 1/29/2021, go to your CLAIM REVIEW tab. Next, click on 'Voids and Adjustments' Select Payer * NEBRASKA DHHS and ICN# (that particular ICN you noted down) (In this case T1234567891).







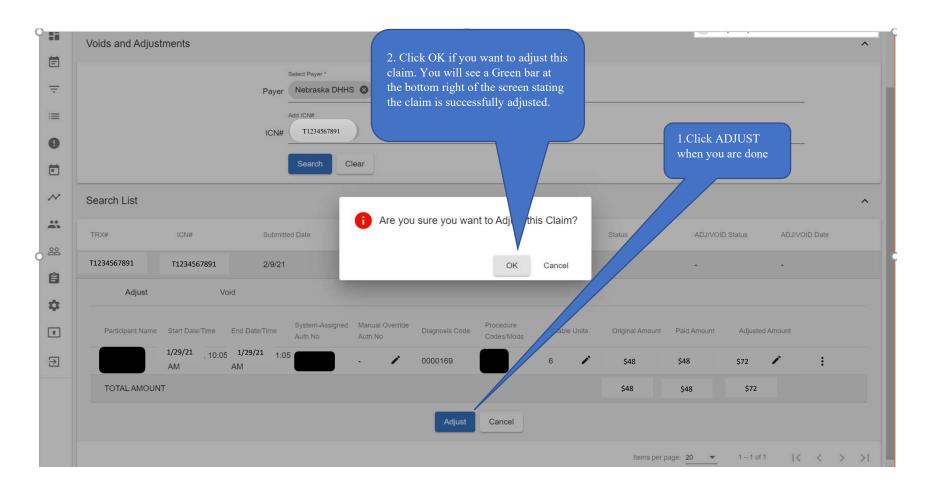




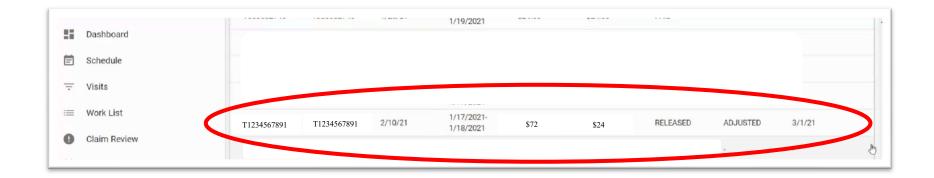
