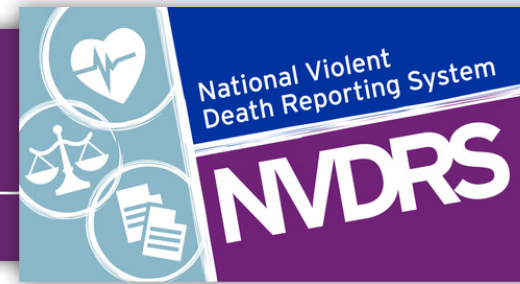
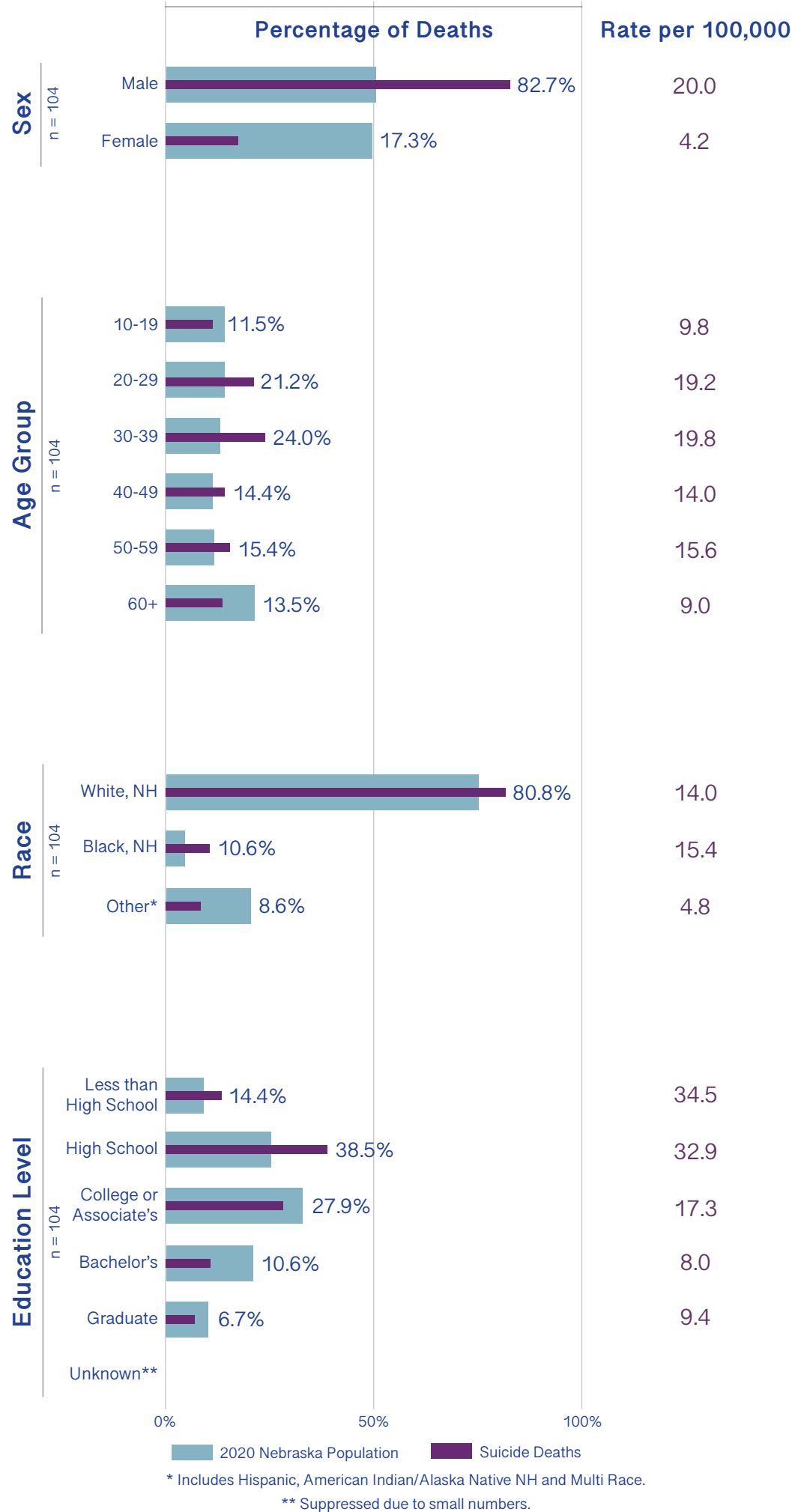


CDC NeVDRS - 2020 Summary of Suicide Deaths in Nebraska Behavioral Health Region 6



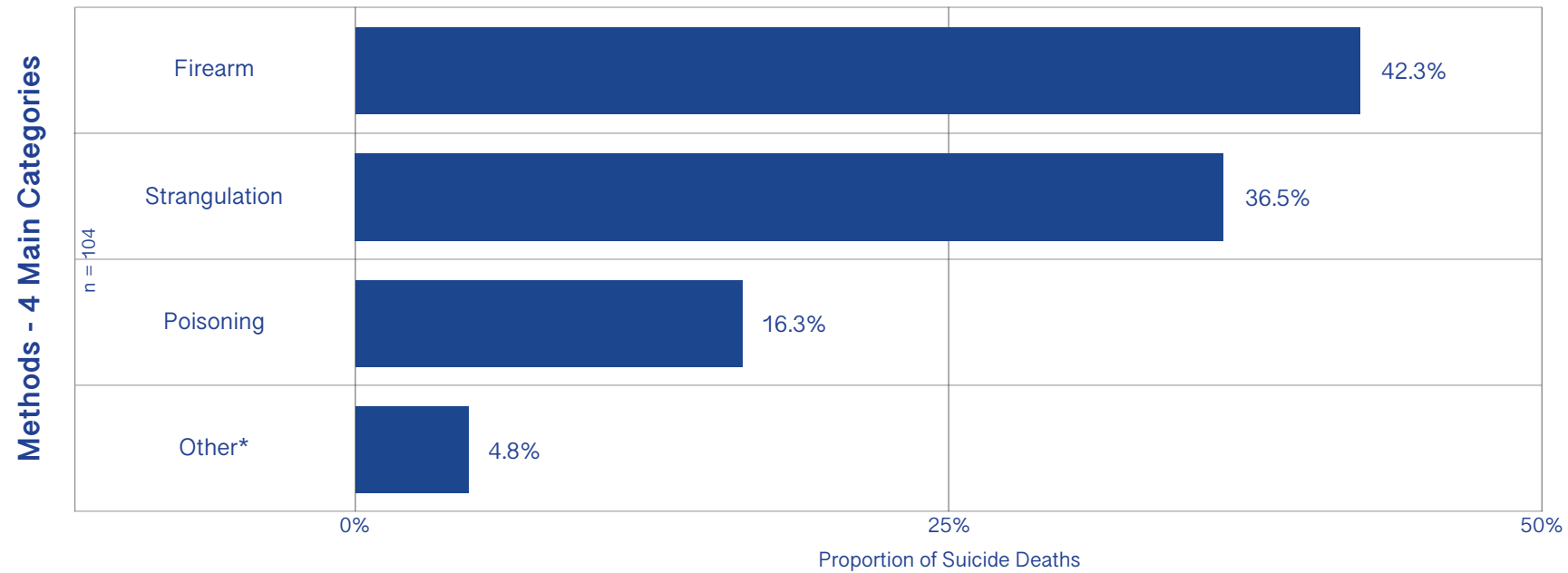

Demographics



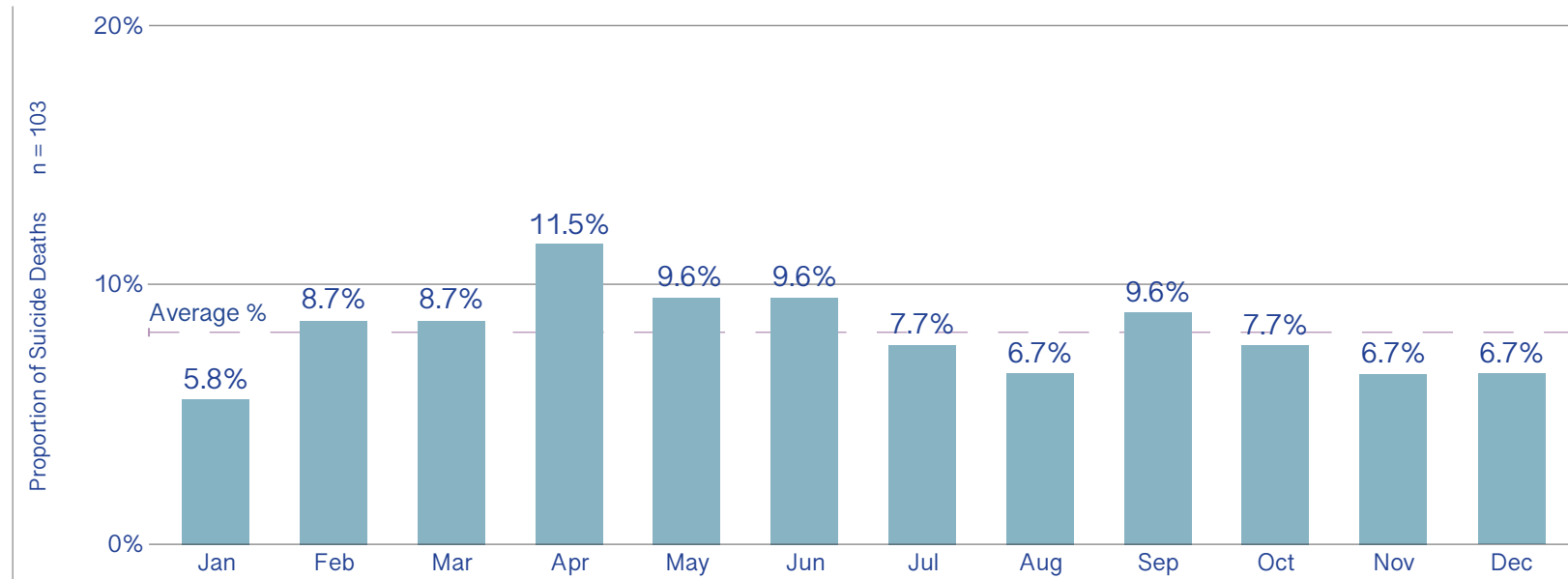
In 2020, white males with a high school education between the ages 30-39 most frequently died from suicide. Black people and American Indian or Alaska Native were disproportionately impacted by suicide in Region 6.

What methods were used?



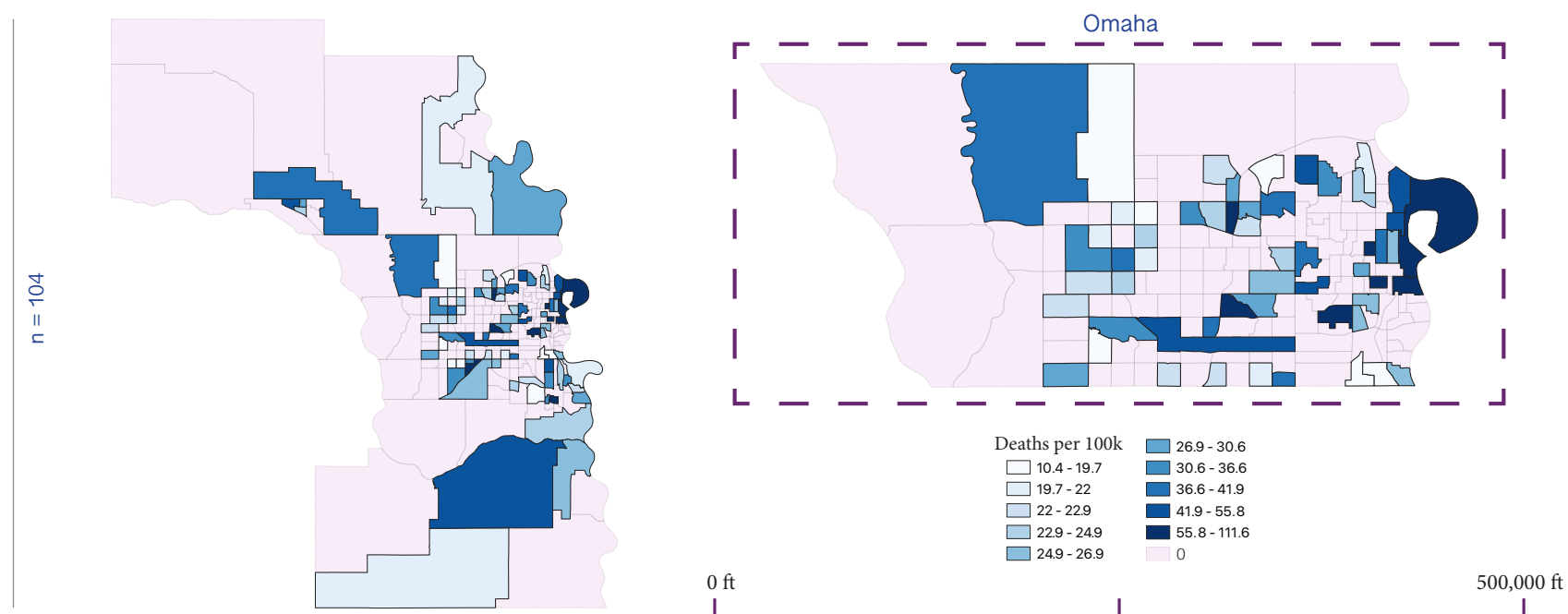
Among those who died by suicide in 2020 in Nebraska Behavioral Health Region 6, males were most likely to use firearms or strangulation, and females were most likely to use poisoning (including drug overdose).

Suicide Deaths by Months



In 2020, around 38.9% of those who died by suicide in Nebraska Behavioral Health Region 6 died from April through July.

Death Rate by Census Tracts in Region 6



The darker blue areas on this map represent the highest rate of suicide deaths in Region 6 in 2020.



77.6% of total suicide deaths took place in a residence.

31.6% of total victims had previous mental health problems.
29.6% of total victims had a history of suicidal ideation.

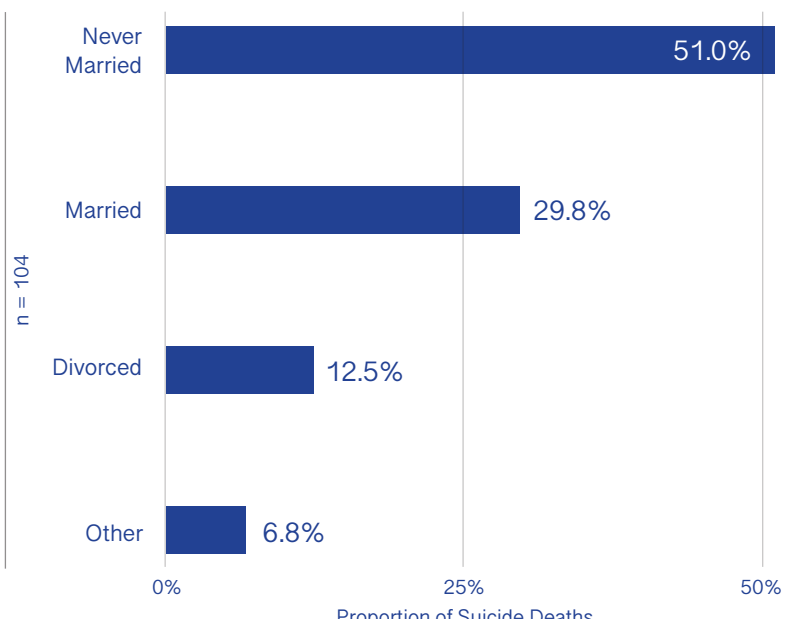
25.5% of suicide victims disclosed intent.
18.4% of total victims had a history of suicide attempts.
28.6% of total victims had a history of alcohol abuse.
21.4% of total victims had a history of abusing non-alcoholic substances.

37.8% of total suicide victims left suicide notes.

19.4% of total victims had served in military.
