System of Care: Local NeSOC Teams

Each region has different, individualized goals and priorities based on the needs and demographics of their coverage area. Local Teams meet regularly to assess, plan and strategize the delivery of system of care services specific to their area. Teams are comprosed of representatives from:

- Local Behavioral Health Authority
- Child Welfare (DHHS Children and Family Services)
- Administrative Office of Probation (Probation)
- DHHS Divisions of Developmental Disabilities and Public Health.
- Courts/legal representatives
- Law enforcement
- Schools and Educational Service Units (ESU)
- Local providers
- Family organizations
- Community collaboratives
- Local health and behavioral health programs



Regions may convene more than one team based on their coverage area. Teams are meeting regularly in the following locations.
