

Service Name	SUBSTANCE USE DISORDER ADDENDUM – YOUTH AND ADULT
Setting	Outpatient services are rendered in a professional office, clinic, home or other environment appropriate to the provision of psychotherapy or substance use services.
License	As required by DHHS Division of Public Health.
Basic Definition	The purpose of the addendum is to clarify/update the treatment needs and recommendations and/or gather information that covers the time frame where an individual was not receiving treatment.
Service Expectations basic expectations for more detail see Title 471 chapter 20	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Medicaid will provide reimbursement for one substance abuse addendum per treatment episode. • If the individual remains involved continuously in treatment for more than one year, an addendum is reimbursable at the annual date of the initial substance abuse assessment. • If the individual leaves treatment prior to a successful discharge and fails to return within six months, the provider will assess the need for an addendum or a new substance abuse assessment. • The need for updated information is to be reflective of the individual’s current status, functioning, and treatment goals. • The addendum will reflect information that has not been addressed in the clinical notes and capture information that covers the period of time outside of treatment. • Continued assessment for co-occurring conditions throughout the addendum and a referral made to appropriately licensed clinician for further assessment when necessary. • All staff will be educated/trained in recovery principles and trauma informed care.
Staffing	The substance use disorder addendum will be completed by a licensed clinician who is working within their scope of practice (i.e. training, experience, and/or education in substance use disorder treatment). Providers may include the following: physician, physician assistant, APRN, psychologist, provisional psychologist, LIMHP, LMHP PLMHP, LADC or PLADC.
Staffing Ratio	One staff member to conduct the assessment.
Desired Individual Outcome	Completed addendum with treatment planning identified.
