## WHAT IS THE DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES ADULT DAY (DDAD) WAIVER?

The DDAD Waiver provides services for people ages 21 and over who have developmental disabilities. These services are intended to maximize a participant's independence to work in their communities. There is a focus on competitive, integrated employment.





#### WHAT DO DDAD WAIVER SERVICES INCLUDE?

In general, DDAD Waiver services include:

Assistive Technology;
Habilitative Day Services;
Home and Vehicle Modifications;
Personal Emergency Response System (PERS);
Vocational Services; and
Respite.

### WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE DDAD WAIVER?

To be eligible for the DDAD Waiver, a participant must be 21 years of age or older, have a developmental disability, be eligible for Medicaid, and meet the level of care for an Intermediate Care Facility for Individuals with Intellectual Disabilities (ICF/IID).
