

FREE ONLINE CLASS FOR INDIVIDUALS WITH INTELLECTUAL OR DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES AND PROVIDERS



Together We Can! is a free e-learning course designed for individuals with intellectual or developmental disabilities and their independent (non-specialized) providers.

Independent providers are persons working under contract with the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services to provide services and supports for individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability.

Together We Can! includes six modules that provide information on how an individual and provider can work together to increase the individual's opportunities to live, work and participate in the community. The course is designed to allow the individual and provider to take the modules together or separately. Those taking the course may complete all of the modules or only those in which they are interested and at their own pace and schedule. The course may also be beneficial to others, including family members of persons with intellectual or developmental disabilities.

Together We Can! was developed by Fritz & O'Hare Associates and Southeast Community College through a grant from the Nebraska Planning Council on Developmental Disabilities. To access the course, go to:
