<u>468-000-212 CHILD CARE DISREGARD FOR GRANT</u>: The amount paid for child care may be allowed up to the adjusted earned income (gross earned income minus the appropriate earned income disregard).

EXAMPLE: Ms. A has income of \$700 a month. She has child care expenses of \$350 a month for her three children. The maximum child care disregard she would be allowed is \$560 (\$700 minus \$140 earned income disregard); therefore her total expense of \$350 is allowed.

Ms. B has income of \$760 a month. She has child care expenses of \$620 a month for her three children. The maximum child care disregard she would be allowed is \$608 (\$760 minus \$152 earned income disregard).
