# Women's & Men's Health Nebraska Colon Cancer Screening Program Lab Data Entry for Med-It



## **OVERVIEW:**

Nebraska Colon Cancer Screening Program (NCP) is a colon cancer screening program that offers enrollment, screening and education to Nebraska men and women who are 45-74 years of age. Tests and services may include fecal immunochemical test FIT kit for at home testing, colonoscopy and information about healthy living. All screening tests are based upon personal and family history.

### **HOW TO LOGIN TO MED-IT:**



Nebraska has two separate databases to enter FIT kit results.

Nebraska distributes FIT kits in two different ways.

- 1. Program enrollment: These are entered into the Nebraska Colon Program Database (NE)
  - Kits that start with AGM Med-It Side (NE)
  - Kits with no numbers or anything Med-It Side (NE)
  - Search by: Date of Birth Client Name
- 2. Community Distribution: These are entered into the Nebraska Colon Coalition Database (CC)
  - Kits that start with AGC Coalition Side (CC)
  - Kits with HUB acronym and 23 Coalition Side (CC)
     Examples: CD23-0001, EC23-0001, EL23-0001, LAN23-0001, PN23-0001, SH23-0001
  - Search by: FIT #
     Date of Birth
     Client Name

The following instructions show you how to identify Kits and what database to enter them into:



The next two screens you see are online service agreement and terms of use information. Please review and proceed through each time you enter into Med-It.

Click 'Proceed" to continue. You'll have to click 'Proceed' two times


You are now logged into the Med-It Database Management System.



### **HOW TO SEARCH FOR CLIENTS:**

AGM and kits without any numbers or anything they are an NCP (NE side) client. \*There is not an FIT# for these clients.


Search by: Date of Birth Client Name



If there is AGC or HUB Acronym with 23 on the vial they are a CHH client (CC side). These will have a unique kit number assigned on the inside flap.

Search by: FIT #



- If client is not in the system:
  - Notify Aaron Sweazy by emailing <a href="mailto:dhhs.nccsp@nebraska.gov">dhhs.nccsp@nebraska.gov</a> name on Vial
  - o Also: Kit Number (if there is one)
  - Wait one (1) week and search again.
  - If client is still not in system after waiting a week, contact Aaron Sweazy again by emailing the FIT sheet to CRC Email dhhs.nccsp@nebraska.gov
- CHH will be notified that the client is not in the system or there is not a cycle started for the current year.

## **Entering Initial Test Results:**

- Make sure current cycle is highlighted
- Click on the CRC Data tab
- Click on Initial Test Result/Follow Up in the drop down menu


