Pre-Admission Screening and Resident Review

In response to the coronavirus pandemic, Nebraska Medicaid is making temporary changes to its requirements around pre-admission screening and resident review (PASRR) for Medicaid beneficiaries living in nursing homes. These changes will ensure services continue for residents and facilities can continue to receive payment.

Changes to PASRR:

Nebraska now has more in regards to PASRRs that require a new PASRR on or before the expiration date established by the short-term PASRR. These types of PASRRs include categorical, 30 day hospital exempt and short-term Level II PASRRs.

Nursing facilities will be responsible for submitting a new PASRR 7-10 days prior to the expiration date of the short-term PASRR to Maximus.

If extraordinary circumstances exist and the new PASRR cannot be completed by Maximus prior to the expiration date of the current short-term PASRR, Maximus will contact Medicaid Long-Term Care and Institutional Services to implement up to a 30-day waiver to complete the renewal PASRR.

Medicaid Long-Term Care and Institutional Services will ensure claims continue to be paid as long as the renewal is completed within the 30-day period.
