questions submitted to Children's Bureau	<ul> <li>What are the limitations of the QRTP setting?-Debi indicated that there is nothing in the law that says it has to be a large group setting, but it cannot be a foster home</li> <li>Regarding the waiver for the 'qualified individual' completing the QRTP assessment, is the Children's Bureau open to a process for managing conflicts of interest that may exist or is the process only for appearances of conflict of interest?-Yes, they are open to waivers and working with conflict of interests</li> <li>Can the Children's Bureau provide a logic model of how the QRTP assessment is to be completed within 30 days of placement when the child has already been placed in the QRTP and had a separate assessment completed for treatment planning purposes?-No, they cannot provide a logic model</li> </ul>
