Policy: To ensure a licensee in a Family Child Care Home I or a primary provider in a

Family Child Care Home II has completed a business module developed by

the Early Childhood Training Center (ECTC).

Purpose: To ensure any proposed equivalent to completion of the business module is

approved by the Department.

Scope: The scope of this standard operating procedure lies within the Division of

Public Health Licensure Unit.

Responsibilities: Staff have various responsibilities for ensuring a business module of training is

completed by the licensee or primary provider.

Definitions: N/A

Procedure: The Office of Children's Services Licensing will accept, in the form of an

official written transcript, the following equivalencies for Business

Management Training:

Education/Training Option

• Completion of a course/class in Early Childhood Administration obtained from an accredited institution of higher learning. Institutions include those programs which offer an Associate's (2 year) or Bachelor's (4 year) degree.

 Completion of Getting Down to Business Training or Child Care Center Management Training developed by the Early Childhood Training Center (ECTC).

Experience Option

- At least 5 years of consecutive experience as the primary provider in a licensed Family Child Care
 Home I or II AND the licensed facility was not subject to a discipline, whether imposed or withdrawn
 during that time period; OR
- At least 5 years of consecutive experience as a Director of a licensed child care center or preschool
 program; AND the director or facility was not subject to a discipline, whether imposed or withdrawn
 during the time the individual served as director.

Expected Results/Measurements: Licensees and primary providers will meet either Business Management training or equivalency requirements.
