All providers who receive federal funds for the provision of Medicaid/CHIP services are obligated to make language services available to those with Limited English Proficiency (LEP) under Title VI of the Civil Rights Act and Section 504 of the Rehab Act of 1973. Neither the Heritage Health plans nor Medicaid is responsible for providing or reimbursing this service.

The Heritage Health plans are responsible for providing interpretation services to their members when the member is interacting directly with their health plan. The Heritage Health plans may choose to provide interpretation services for a member to interact with a provider, but that service would be a value-added service offered solely at the individual health plan's discretion.
