RE: Billing for Speech Therapy services in the community and school-based services.

This provider bulletin is being issued as a reminder to Medicaid providers of billing requirements for providing services in schools. When services are provided in a school and the provider is contracted by the school to provide school-based services for special education children the provider cannot bill Nebraska Medicaid fee-for-service or a Heritage Health Plan.

According to 471 NAC 2-002.03 billing Nebraska Medicaid twice for the same service, or billing both Nebraska Medicaid and another insurer or government program would constitute duplicate billing and is prohibited.
