**SUBJECT:** Procedure Adjustments to Care Management Client Contribution Letters and Sliding Fee Scale Payments

**CONTENT:** It is not required to offer the opportunity to voluntarily contribute to Care Management clients, for Care Management services, whose income is at, or below 149% of the Federal Poverty level, and at the \$0 payment on the 15 NAC 2 Sliding Fee Scale.

Previously, Care Management Units offered the opportunity to voluntarily contribute to all Care Management clients, using the sliding fee scale. Because Care Management is a state only program, it has been determined that OAA does not overrule State Statutes, and therefore, CASA and Care Management, as State Acts, with State funding, are separate and distinct from OAA.
