SUBJECT: Under 60 Individual Giving a Voluntary Contribution for a 60 or Over Individual

at a Congregate Meal Site

**CONTENT:** This program instruction supersedes SUA-14-PI-04 and SUA-18-PI-08.

Individuals who are 60 or older are considered to be eligible according to the Older Americans Act (OAA) and can give a suggested contribution for a congregate meal. Individuals who are under 60 are considered ineligible according to the OAA must pay the full cost for congregate meal.

An individual who is under 60 years of age (ineligible) can assist or physically give the suggested contribution, for an eligible individual, only if both individuals are present at the congregate meal site during the time the contribution is made.
