Re: NCPDP D.0 Format Modification for CII Drugs

This provider bulletin is being issued to notify Medicaid providers of a new Quantity Prescribed field requirement intended to help identify and differentiate a CII claim that is a partial or incremental fill, versus a prescription refill.

Pharmacy: Information Regarding this Ruling

The federal DHHS finalized a rule, CMS-0055, which, requires an internal edit to the Quantity Prescribed (460-ET) field on the NCPDP D.0 format for retail pharmacy transactions for all CII drugs. The edit requires the field to be populated with the quantity prescribed.

The Quantity Prescribed (460-ET) field on claims must be completed on claims submitted on and after September 21, 2020.
