


The Pie Chart on the right further categorizes the Child Abuse/Neglect reports and groups them as either Accepted for Assessment or Screened Out. Screened out reports are reports that did not meet the level of severity or definition of Child Abuse and Neglect that require assessment by a Children and Family Specialist.






