Population Data was derived from the U.S. Census estimates in the year they were published for the corresponding year.




The chart above represents the reports related to child abuse received by the Department of Health and Human Services during Calendar Year 2010. There were a total of 33,081 reports categorized as follows:

• Dependent Child: 934 (2.8%)

• CPS Information/Referral: 3,483 (10.5%)

• Child Abuse/Neglect: 28,664 (86.6%)

The Pie Chart on the right further categorizes the Child Abuse/Neglect reports and groups them as either Accepted for Assessment or Screened Out. Screened out reports are reports that did not meet the level of severity or definition of Child Abuse and Neglect that required assessing by a Children and Family Specialist.
















