

Planning Process

- **The planning process will rely on equal partnership among youth, family and system partners**
- **The planning process will be participatory**
 - Participatory planning promotes recognition and ownership of identified issues.
- **The planning process will be multidimensional**
- **The planning process will be meaningful**
 - The planning process will result in a shared vision for healthy change along with a plan that includes sustainable goals, strategies, action steps, timelines and accountabilities.

Steps

Simple steps:

- ✓ Confirm groups for planning.
- ✓ Identify system, family and youth leaders as points of contact
- ❑ Convene planning groups
- ❑ Conduct ongoing engagement, team building and education/learning throughout the process.
- ❑ Conduct assessment/information gathering
- ❑ Use data to understand multi-dimensional “readiness level” (or starting points) for each core strategy area and each region
- ❑ Develop a shared vision that builds on existing strengths and progress
- ❑ Develop goals, strategies, action steps, timelines, accountabilities and recommendations


