Service	Functional Family Preservation
Definition	Functional Family Preservation – delivered in the family home or community setting by a licensed or provisionally licensed therapist and skill builder. Designed to focus on families with older youth and to address areas of concern affecting the youth and family. Designed to improve youth behaviors through behavior management programming, family functioning, school attendance and performance, and enhancing peer relationships. May be referred when child/youth are placed in the family home, or in preparation for reunification. Designed to assist the family in identifying and accessing formal and informal supports. 24/7 crisis management/stabilization are part of the service plan. This service includes both face-to-face direct contact and indirect e.g. telephones call, email with the family.
Target Population	This service is available to families with older youth working with DHHS. Specific emphasis on delinquent youth and families.
Length of Service	15 weeks
Established Rate	DHHS shall pay the Contractor \$420.00 per case per week for a maximum for 15 weeks. Payment will only be made for weeks when the Contractor is actively providing services for the family.

Service	Unification
Definition	Unification Services –delivered in the family home or community setting by a trained professional. Designed to improve family functioning, increase access to community resources, and preservation of the family unit through a three phase approach. May be referred when child/youth are placed in the family home, or in preparation for reunification. Trained professional will specifically assist parents in learning ways to implement behavioral management programming in the home, and to provide appropriate discipline when necessary.
Target Population	This service is available to any family who is working with the DHHS
Length of Service	56 days
Established Rate	DHHS shall pay the Contractor \$57.14 per case per day for a maximum of 56 days. If the service is terminated early, payment will only be made through the date the services were terminated.
