




## Referred Families with a PHRP Scheduled Prior to 12 Month Permanency Review Hearing


## Youth Involved in a PHDR That Addressed Discharge from Foster Care to Reunification within the 12 Month Target Period


# Youth Involved in a PHR That Addressed Other Permanency Planning




**Child Welfare Case Referred to Pre-Hearing Termination of Parental Rights (PHTPR) Conferences and Resulting in Facilitation**


# PHTPRs Scheduled within 14 Days of Receiving Notice of a TPR Trial/Hearing


# PHPRs and PHTPRs with a Parent or Legal Guardian Present
