5.	infant at home NOT in HHS custody--mom as semi supervised visits with the children referred
6.	giving mom a chance as S.T.A.R. court
7.	referred too soon

1.	Father complying
2.	Too soon--case only open 7-8 months
3.	Mom making progress
4.	HHS does not support
5.	HHS ICWA expert doesn't think there is enough to file
Quarter 3	
1.	mom on waiting list for treatment--if she leaves treatment or something concerning happes re-refer
2.	child placed at home with mom and dad mia--no reason to file on dad
