CASE MANAGEMENT SUBGRANT

NEBRASKA FAMILIES COLLABORATIVE

AMENDMENT ONE, JULY 2014

This agreement is entered into by and between the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services, **DIVISION OF CHILDREN AND FAMILY SERVICES** (hereinafter "DHHS"), and **NEBRASKA FAMILIES COLLABORATIVE** (hereinafter "Subrecipient").

The agreement between the parties dated June, 2014 is hereby amended as follows:

Article II, Section L. is amended to read:


- L. The Subrecipient is not responsible for payment of the following:
1. Services paid by Medicaid, private insurance or alternative funding source;
 2. Physical health care costs of children, youth and families not otherwise paid by a parent, Medicaid, or other third party.
 3. Services funded by State Ward Education;
 4. Cost of placement in the Youth Rehabilitation and Treatment Center at Kearney and Geneva or a Nebraska Detention facility;
 5. Adoption and Guardianship Subsidies;
 6. Maintenance payments for a ward's child;
 7. State ward independent living maintenance payments;
 8. Case management and extended services for a young adult who has entered into a voluntary services and support agreement under the Young Adult Voluntary Services and Support Act except those requirements under said Act that should be performed prior to the time the young adult reaches 19 years of age and is discharged from foster care.
 9. Therapeutic Group Home room and board.

All other costs associated with the performance of this subgrant are the responsibility of the Subrecipient. This includes, but is not limited to: court ordered services for which Subrecipient is unable to secure alternate funding sources and assistance with funeral costs, if requested by family or legal guardian, for any child who dies while in the legal custody of DHHS or while being actively served under this subgrant without court involvement.

It has been the practice of the parties for DHHS to be responsible for the cost of room and board for Therapeutic Group Home placements because that was an unanticipated expense at the time the original agreement was signed by the parties in 2009. All other terms and conditions remain in full force and effect.

IN WITNESS THEREOF, the parties have duly executed this subgrant hereto, and each party acknowledges the receipt of a duly executed copy of this subgrant with original signatures.


