

What forms are required for 16, 17 and 18 year old youths (not the EF parents).

Once a dependent child age 16, 17 or 18 becomes EF mandatory s/he must cooperate with EF in order to still qualify as a dependent child and remain grant eligible. Once EF mandatory s/he must be provided an orientation and complete the assessment, a Service Plan, and their own Self-Sufficiency Contract. See 468 NAC 2-007 and 2-020.02 #1.

Since the dependent child does not drive the time limits for the family, they would not accrue time-limited months. The line on the Self-Sufficiency Contract (WP-6) referencing the time limits would be crossed out, but the other provisions would apply.
