

**In order to receive the five months of Transitional Grants, must the family have received an ADC Grant in the month immediately preceding ineligibility?**

Yes. Unlike Transitional Medical Assistance (TMA), in order to receive the five months of Transitional Grants, the family must have received a "regular" ADC Grant payment in the month immediately preceding their ineligibility. The ADC Grant in the final month of eligibility must be an actual Grant payment issued to the family. ADC Grant "eligibility" where the Grant amount was less than \$10/month so no actual Grant payment was issued will not entitle the family to Transitional Payments. They may indeed still qualify for Transitional Medical Assistance, but they will not qualify for Transitional Payments.

In addition, the last ADC Grant issued to the family prior to ineligibility must have been issued by Nebraska.
