

Are there any exceptions to the supportive service guidelines on relocation assistance found at 468-000-309, page 1?

Exceptions to the guidelines on relocation assistance may be allowed under special circumstance and with approval from the EF Unit in Central Office, i.e. to escape domestic violence; into affordable housing, e.g. HUD subsidized housing, etc.

Some examples for which relocation assistance is not allowed:

- Relocating a participant to attend education or training out of state if such education and training opportunities are available locally.
- Relocating a participant in order to accept employment that is temporary or entry level, low paying and/or readily available in the local labor market.
- Relocating a participant who wishes to move because of personal preference or because they are forced to move.
