

In order for a client to be eligible for the six months of transitional supportive services, how many grants must they have received before losing grant eligibility due to earned income?

The number of ADC grants received has nothing to do with the client/participant's eligibility for up to 6 months of EF transitional supportive services. There is no correlation with TMA, TMA-G or TCC eligibility requirements. Policy states that the client must be either cooperating with or participating in EF at the time they lose grant eligibility due to earned income, 468-000-309, page 3, Supportive Services Following Ineligibility for a Grant.

This could also include someone who has applied for and been determined eligible for ADC but maybe hasn't received a grant yet, or has not yet signed an EF Self-Sufficiency Contract, but was motivated enough to secure employment right away. They would be considered to be cooperating with EF since they have not overtly indicated their refusal to participate in EF nor have they had their ADC case and adult medical closed for failing to cooperate with EF.

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
