**GOAL:** Facilitate an expert Seminar with a Table Top Exercise (TTX) that will enhance the current capabilities and knowledge related to the operation of a MEGA Shelter and the care displaced populations.

## **OBJECTIVES:**

- Prepare for participation in National Capstone Full Scale Exercise (FSE) scheduled for August 2016 – Missouri simulates displacement of hundreds of thousands of people to shelter in Nebraska
- Address gaps for at-risk populations and provide guidance for participating organizations to update plans for communicative barriers and functional need accessibility
- Identify critical infrastructure for preparedness and response to activate a MEGA shelter
- Identify critical personnel for vaccination, surveillance, and investigation of potential disease outbreaks and pandemics
- Provide information on lessons learned from past disasters
- Create awareness and coalition building between the private and government sectors
