THE POSITION CURRENTLY VACANT MUST BE FILLED BY AN ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELOR WHO IS ALSO LICENSED AS A PSYCHOLOGIST OR MENTAL HEALTH PRACTITIONER.

### PERSONAL INTERVIEWS

The Professional Boards Committee of the Board of Health will meet during the morning of November 18<sup>th</sup> in Lincoln to review all applications and supporting documentation, conduct personal interviews with applicants, and formulate recommendations for board appointments. If this date or location present an issue for you, please contact Board of Health staff to discuss potential options.

These personal interviews last approximately 10 minutes and will be scheduled to provide applicants the opportunity to inform the Professional Boards Committee of their goals and desires for serving on the board and to respond to questions presented by members of the Committee. After application, you will be notified if you are selected for an interview.

#### APPOINTMENTS AND NOTIFICATION OF APPOINTMENTS

The Professional Boards Committee recommendations for appointments will be submitted to all Board of Health members and appointments will be made at the Board of Health meeting scheduled for the afternoon of November 18, 2019.

The Licensure Unit will notify applicants after the Board of Health meeting as to whether or not they were appointed to the Board of Alcohol and Drug Counseling.
