



## EDUCATION PRE-APPROVED FOR INITIAL LICENSURE AS AN ALCOHOL AND DRUG COUNSELOR

BASED ON 172 NAC 15

APPROVAL PERIOD OF JANUARY 1, 2018 - DECEMBER 31, 2022

Educational institutions may request pre-approval of courses as meeting the 270 hours of education for initial licensure as an alcohol and drug counselor.
