ALL BOARD MEMBERS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Additional criteria for members of the board: 1) one member who is a volunteer emergency medical care provider; 2) one member who is a paid emergency medical care provider; 3) one member who is a firefighter; 4) one member who is a law enforcement officer; and 5) one member who is active in the critical incident stress management program. If a person appointed to the board is qualified to serve as a member in more than one of these capacities, all qualifications of such person shall be taken into consideration to determine whether or not the diversity in qualifications required have been met. At least five members of the board shall be appointed from each congressional district, and at least one of such members shall be a physician member.

Public Member	<p>At the time of appointment and while serving as a public member, an individual shall meet the following requirements.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Resident of Nebraska for one (1) year and remain a resident of Nebraska while serving as a board member At least nineteen (19) years of age Represent the interests and viewpoints of the public SHALL NOT hold an active credential in any profession or business subject to the Uniform Credentialing Act, issued in Nebraska or in any other jurisdiction, at any time during the five (5) years prior to appointment SHALL NOT be eligible for appointment to a board which regulates a profession or business in which that person has ever held a credential SHALL NOT be or not have been, at any time during the year prior to appointment, an employee of a member of a profession credentialed by the department, of a facility credentialed pursuant to the Health Care Facility Licensure Act, or of a business credentialed pursuant to the Uniform Credentialing Act SHALL NOT be the parent, child, spouse, or household member of any person presently regulated by the board SHALL HAVE NO material financial interest in the profession or business regulated by this board SHALL NOT be a member or employee of the legislative or judicial branch of state government.
