## **6. UPDATES/REPORTS/STATISTICS**

### a. Regulation Review Update

Chiles reported the regulations had been reviewed by Legal and forwarded to the Governor's Policy Research Office for approval to hold a public hearing. When scheduled, Chiles will notify members of the hearing date.

### b. Professional Updates: Body Art, Cosmetology, Electrology, Esthetics, Nail Technology and Indoor Tanning Facilities

Body Art: Judkins reported that the Heritage Tattoo Conference (relating to Human Trafficking & the Tattoo Industry), was held on May 23<sup>rd</sup> and was very successful.

- There is a new group being formed called the Nebraska Licensed Professionals Against Human Trafficking and Domestic Violence
- Money was raised at the conference for the Women's Center for Advancement in Omaha, which is a safe place for anyone who is experiencing domestic violence, sexual assault, stalking, or human trafficking <https://wcaomaha.org>
- 70-80 attended the conference
- 25-30 attended the tattoo specific sessions
- Take away from the conference were:
  - Awareness of what a tattoo design may represent
  - Don't approach trafficker
  - Posters are available, with a tear way phone number contact, if you suspect human trafficking

Cosmetology: Hornig reported that the references for the NIC instructor examination has changed to include *McKeachie's Teaching Tips: Strategies, Research, and Theory for College and University Teachers*, in addition to *Milady's Master Educator Student Course Book* and *Mindful Teaching Pro eBook* by Pivot Point International, Inc. Others reported that in California, booth rental is illegal, and salons are using gender neutral pricing based on the time it takes to complete the service.

Electrology: There was no report.

Esthetics: There was no report.

Nail Technology: There was no report.

Indoor Tanning Facilities: Pettigrew reported she will be attending a tanning convention in St Louis in October

c. National-Interstate Council of State Boards of Cosmetology (NIC)

The NIC annual meeting is scheduled for September 6-9, 2019, in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Registration fees are \$450 if registering by July 12, \$475 from July 13-July 31, and \$500 on August 1<sup>st</sup>; 6 meals are included with registration. Nordboe and Rowland voiced interest in attending the conference.
