RE: NAMIS & NAPIS Provider Type

The State Program Report (SPR) details the number of direct services provided by Area Agencies on Aging (AAAs). Providers must be listed correctly in the aging software, NAMIS.

The three Provider Types are: AAA, Senior Center, and Other. There should be only one AAA Provider Type designation – the Area Agency on Aging. Senior Centers should be listed as a Provider Type: Senior Center. Any other Service Provider should be designated as Provider Type: Other. Meal Sites and Nutritional Sites should be listed as Provider Type: Other.

The image below correctly reflects the use of Provider Type: Senior Center, Other, and AAA.

NAPIS Provider Type must accurately reflect whether the AAA provides direct service or not. The AAA should be the only Provider that is listed as NAPIS Provider Type: AAA Direct Srvc Provision.

Any other provider (Provider Type: Other or Senior Center) need to be marked, NAPIS Provider Type: Not AAA Direct Provider.

This PI will supercede any previously issued PIs or IMs that provide guidance on Provider Type data entry.
