

## Nebraska MMIS Replacement Procurement Information

### **Data Management and Analytics (DMA)**

1. Priority for Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS).
2. Scope includes:
  - a. Medicaid enterprise data warehouse
  - b. Decision support system
  - c. Reporting and analytics
  - d. Program integrity tools including case management
  - e. Encounter processing
  - f. Staff augmentation for analytics and program integrity (i.e., informatics analysts, certified fraud investigators, etc.)
3. Draft RFP released February 11, 2016.
4. Final RFP targeted for May 2016 release.

### **Claims Broker Services (CBS) with Heritage Health Managed Care Organization (MCO)**

1. Nebraska is moving away from the traditional MMIS/fiscal agent model.
2. Nebraska's current program vision is to transition most of the remaining fee-for-service populations into Heritage Health, which includes the provision of pharmacy, physical health and behavioral health services through three MCOs. Plan leverages existing infrastructure of a Heritage Health MCO for processing the small volume of fee-for-service claims.
3. Nebraska is working with CMS on the concept and funding.
4. MCOs have indicated interest in pursuing this innovative solution.
5. Intent to award announced February 5, 2016.
6. Timeframe for CBS implementation has not been determined.

### **Enrollment Broker (EB) Services and Capitation Processing**

1. DHHS is seeking a vendor to provide MCO enrollment services for its new managed care program, Heritage Health.
2. Eligibility determination will occur within the current eligibility system.
3. Future integration with the new eligibility and enrollment solution will be required.
4. Capitation processing by the EB will be phased in at a later date.
5. Capitation payments will continue to be generated by Nebraska's current financial system. The EB will determine the payment and any recoupment amounts.
6. RFP published on December 28, 2015. Proposals are due on February 23, 2016.

### **Independent Validation and Verification (IV &V)**

1. DHHS will be seeking a vendor to provide IV & V services for the Data Management and Analytics (DMA) project and the Eligibility and Enrollment Solution (EES) project with the ability to issue task orders for other Medicaid projects.
2. RFP targeted for release in February 2016.
3. Target contract start date is July 2016.
