RE: Prior Authorizations through Telligen and ICD-10 Implementation

Please share this information with all administrative, clinical, IT, coding, and billing staff for Hospice and Private Duty Nursing providers.

This bulletin gives ICD-10 implementation instructions to providers participating in Nebraska Medicaid fee-for-service and who utilize prior authorization services through Telligen.

The United States Department of Health and Human Services requires that all HIPAA covered entities use the International Classification of Diseases, 10th Revision, (ICD-10) codes beginning October 1, 2015.

Providers must enter the ICD-CM primary diagnosis code on all prior authorizations.

Only ICD-9 codes will be accepted on prior authorization forms for dates of service **before** October 1, 2015.

Only ICD-10 codes will be accepted on prior authorization forms for dates of service **on or after** October 1, 2015.

Telligen has end-dated all existing prior authorizations for September 30, 2015, and has notified providers who are impacted. Providers should resubmit prior authorization

requests with ICD-10 codes for dates of service on or after October 1, 2015, for services that are still needed.

Telligen has notified providers that prior authorization requests with dates of service on or after October 1, 2015 are now being accepted.

The Hospice Prior Authorization Request (MS-44) and Certification and Plan of Care for Private Duty Nursing (MS-81) forms have been revised to include ICD Indicator checkboxes. Providers must indicate which code set (i.e., ICD-9 or ICD-10) is being submitted on the Prior Authorization and the Claim form, effective immediately.
