RE: Provider Enrollment for MIPS Services

Please share this information with claims, billing and administrative staff.

The Nebraska Medicaid Program was required to adopt new provider screening and enrollment requirements mandated by Section 6401 of the Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act (PPACA). The requirements can be found in 42 CFR 455. The Nebraska Medicaid Program has established procedures to ensure its provider screening and enrollment processes are compliant with the mandated requirements.

Per 471 NAC 25-002 Special Education School-Based Service, MIPS providers must comply with the Nebraska Medicaid provider enrollment requirements. These requirements apply to providers (therapists) with the school districts who are providing MIPS services to Medicaid recipients. Note, in particular, that the effective date for Service Provider Agreements is the date a complete and signed Service Provider Agreement (MC-19) is received in our office (or future date as specifically requested by a provider).
