RE: Medicaid Drug Rebate Program — National Drug Code (NDC) Reporting Requirement for Physician Administered Drugs

PLEASE SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH ADMINISTRATIVE, CLINICAL
AND BILLING STAFF.

Nebraska Medicaid implemented the National Drug Code (NDC) billing requirements for physician administered drugs effective July 1, 2008. Provider Bulletins 08-02, 08-03, 08-16, and 08-28 urged all providers to begin developing systems as soon as possible in order to meet the mandatory requirement as of July 1, 2008.

Recent claims history indicates that many claims are being submitted with the required data either missing or entered incorrectly on the claim. Claims submitted for payment that do not meet the NDC reporting requirements to include a valid NDC, quantity, and unit of measurement will result in line item denial. Please review the entry of this information and ensure that it is correct and complete.

In addition, only those drugs manufactured by companies (Labelers) participating in the federal Medicaid rebate program are reimbursable under Medicaid. Rebatable Labelers may be located on the DIIHS website at:

<http://www.dhhs.ne.gov/mecl/pharm/RebatableLabelers.aspx>. By entering the NDC label (first 5 digits of the NDC number) in the 'Label' search field, if a rebatable labeler is located, the search results will return the labeler name, and rebate eligibility dates.
