RE: Changes in provider criminal history background check requirements.

This Provider Bulletin clarifies Provider Bulletin 09-29 dated September 8, 2009, same subject.

Effective January 13, 2011 public and commercial transportation service providers under agreement with the Division of Medicaid & Long-Term Care will no longer be required to submit driver fingerprinting and background checks every two years through the Nebraska State Patrol as a requirement to be a transportation provider. All other requirements under Provider Bulletin 09-29 that pertain to services provided under the Divisions of Children and Family Services, Developmental Disabilities, and Public Health remain in effect.
