Nebraska Medicaid providers can access claim information through the internet by using **Medicaid Claim Status Inquiry** (MCCS). Enrollment is simple and information is available on the Department's website at http://dhhs.ne.gov/medicaid/Pages/med_internetaccess.aspx. NCCI & Medicaid Claim Status Inquiry (MCCS)

If a claim is denied due to an edit included in the National Correct Coding Initiative (NCCI), the MCCS will include the CLEID (Correspondence Language Example) number. The CLEID identifies the rationale for an NCCI edit as determined by the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS). The CLEID will not be included on the remittance advice. The CLEID is only available via the MCCS.
