RE: Injectable Medication Fee Schedule

PLEASE SHARE THIS INFORMATION WITH ADMINISTRATIVE, CLINICAL AND BILLING STAFF.

Beginning December 1, 2012, Medicaid will reimburse for practitioner administered injectable medications at ninety-five percent (95%) of the Medicare Drug Fee Schedule. Injectable medications not included on the Medicare Drug Fee Schedule will be reimbursed at the wholesale acquisition cost (WAC) plus 6.8%.

Beginning December 1, 2012, providers are no longer required to submit a cost invoice for medications costing in excess of \$500.00. Specific medications which require a prior authorization are indicated on the fee schedule. Instructions for obtaining that prior authorization are included in the heading of the fee schedule.
