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RE: Paper Claim Processing

Effective December 1, 2012 Pharmacy Providers are encouraged to submit Pharmacy claims through the Magellan Medicaid Administration (MMA) point of sale system in the NCPDP D.0 format. Providers not having systems allowing electronic submission may utilize the interface on the Magellan Medicaid Administration website. Users must have internet access and are required to complete the registration process. To initiate registration, access the UAC link on the MMA website in the upper right corner at <https://nebraska.fhsc.com/>. Providers are encouraged to use the electronic submission since the Department is considering phasing out the NCPDP 1.1 Universal Claim Forms for Nebraska Medicaid.

Currently pharmacies are required to submit a paper NCPDP 1.1 Universal Claim Form to receive payment on a claim used to meet a client's share of cost with a remaining balance. Effective December 1, 2012 providers will be able to electronically submit this claim after obtaining an override. Once the share of cost form has been processed by Nebraska Medicaid, pharmacies should contact the Magellan Medicaid Administration help desk at 800-368-9695 to obtain an override for electronic processing. Providers needing to determine if the client's share of cost has been met for a particular month should contact the Inquiry Line at 877-255-3092, option 1.
