Project Update - Required Forms for Providers

Please Share This Information With Administrative, Billing and IT Staff and Trading Partners.

This Provider Bulletin provides information for all providers enrolled in Nebraska Medicaid who render services to recipients in the Fee-for-Service (FFS) delivery system. Note: Providers participating in the NE managed care delivery system should address EFT/ERA questions directly to the applicable managed care organization (MCO).

The purpose of this Provider Bulletin is to announce the revision of required forms for Medicaid providers who submit transactions and receive payment through MMIS:

- Form MS-84 Enrollment for EFT
 - Used by providers to enroll for EFT payments and designate a bank account for the deposits
- Form MS-85 Nebraska Medicaid Trading Partner Authorization
 - Used by providers to authorize a Trading Partner to transmit 5010 Electronic Transactions on their behalf, except the 835 ERA
- Form MS-86 Nebraska Medicaid Trading Partner ERA/835 Authorization
 - Used by providers to authorize a Trading Partner to transmit the 5010 ERA 835 transaction on their behalf.

Effective immediately, providers should begin using these forms for new enrollments or changes to existing enrollments.

The forms are fillable web-based documents. When completed, the provider can save the document, attach it to an email and submit to our office using the directions given in the form and in the Instructions. Please be sure to use secure email for the EFT Form. Directions for secure email are available in the EFT form instructions.

The new forms are a result of the implementation of the CORE Rules (380/382) requirements for standardized flow, format, terminology, and data elements mandated for these enrollment forms.
