RE: Medicaid Medroxyprogesterone Acetate (Depo-Provera ®) Billing Update

Please share this information with Administrative, Billing, IT Staff and Trading Partners.

The purpose of this bulletin is to provide clarification on the requirements for billing medroxyprogesterone acetate for clients enrolled in fee-for-service Medicaid.

Please use the following codes for dates of service December 22, 2014, and after for claims submissions:

J1050- Injection, medroxyprogesterone acetate, 1mg.

Medroxyprogesterone 400mg/ml products should be billed using this code. The Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) National Drug Code (NDC) crosswalk only contains this strength formulation. Nebraska Medicaid has updated the crosswalk to only contain 400mg/ml formulations for this code.

J3490-TH medroxyprogesterone acetate, 1mg contraceptive.

Medroxyprogesterone contraceptive products should now be billed using this code and modifier. The decision to move the contraceptive products was based on provider concerns of significant under reimbursement for the 150mg/ml formulation. Nebraska Medicaid has updated the crosswalk for contraceptive formulations for this code.
