RE: ICD-10 Version Indicators Missing on Paper Claims

Please share this information with clinical, coding, billing, and IT staff.

This bulletin provides information about paper claims that are deleting due to missing ICD Version Indicators.

The United States Department of Health and Human Services requires all HIPAA covered entities use the International Classification of Diseases, 10th Revision, (ICD-10) codes beginning October 1, 2015.

Paper claims received after September 1, 2015 are being deleted if the ICD Version Indicator is missing or invalid. Please review the deleted claims reports to ensure a new claim is submitted with all necessary information. The ICD Version Indicator is "9" for ICD-9 and is "0" for ICD-10 on CMS-1450 (UB04) and CMS-1500 claim forms. See [Provider Bulletin No. 15-25](#) for additional information.

Reminder: The ICD-10 Version Indicator **and** ICD-10 diagnosis codes must be submitted for services on and after October 1, 2015.
