

DDD Wish for the HRS Process

- There will be 4 Health Risk Screens in total, but only 3 will be completed for each individual. Screens will be completed for all individuals who are receiving medical risk funding will be required annually with the hope of eventually requiring all DD funded individuals to complete screens on an annual basis at some point in the future.

- The 4 HRS screens include:
 - 1) MRS (Medical Risk Screen)
 - 2) PNM (Physical Nutrition Management) Risk Screen
 - 3) EF (Enteral Feeding) Risk Screen
 - 4) SGS (Spine and Gait Screen)

(No changes will be made to the weighted scores or total scores possible. The highest possible scores for each of the screens will still fall around 100 (MCR=100.02, PNM=100.01, EF=100.05, and SG=99.96).

- MRS and SGS will always completed along with either the PNM or the EF screen depending on whether or not an individual has an enteral feeding tube.

- The 3 screens will be completed step-by-step in Therap (within eCHAT).
 - 1) Whoever is completing the screens (Service Coordinator or provider staff) would click on “Health Risk Screens”, and would automatically be taken to the first question of the first screen (MRS) and would be taken through the screen question by question with a chance to enter/type in comments/concerns related to the MRS screen after the last question.
 - 2) Once that screen was completed, they would then be taken to the first question of the SGS screen and taken through the screen question by question with a chance to enter/type in comments/concerns related to the SGS screen after the last question.
 - 3) Once the SGS screen was completed, the person completing the screens would be given a question. Something like “Does this person have an enteral feeding tube?” or “Does this person get 50% or more of his/her nutrition through an enteral feeding tube?” They would then be taken the appropriate 3rd screen (either PNM or EF) and taken through the appropriate screen question by question with a chance to enter/type in comments/concerns related to whichever of these 2 screens was completed after the last question.
 - 4) A total tabulated score for each completed screen as well as the risk level according to that score would then be provided either automatically once the screens were completed or would be available for viewing somewhere in Therap once the screens were completed.
 - 5) Once the screens were completed, a list of required supports would also be generated (based on which screens are completed and which screen questions had “yes” answers”. For example, if question #6 on the MCR screen has an answer of “yes”, then the individual would need a seizure protocol in place. (A list of the questions/combinations of questions that would generate the need for a required support and what required support would be associated with each of these is to be developed and made available once the pilot has been completed and the HRS process and screens have been finalized (target time-frame mid to late-April).
 - 6) Once the HRS screens/process is available in Therap, we would want the ability to:
 - a) See all completed screens for each individual (and/or see which questions had yes answers and any extra comments/concerns that were entered for each screen).
 - b) Run a spreadsheet report that would show all individuals with completed screens at the actual point-in-time that the report is being run. The report would include each of the following:
 - 1) individual’s name
 - 2) 3 separate total scores for each screen completed
 - 3) 3 separate risk levels for each screen completed
 - 4) A total tabulated score of the sum of all 3 screen scores added together.
(The report would need to have the ability of filtering to show the names/information in order of highest 3-score sum total from top to bottom).
